



Legal Centre Lesvos. Fundraiser, Communications, and Donor Relationship Position. Location: Lesvos, Greece. Up to 10 month full time position dependent on start date. Potential to extend.

Do you have some fundraising and donor relationship experience? Are you passionate about human rights, justice and equality? Then join us.

This role would suit someone who is looking for an enriching experience, quite different to any other.

Legal Centre Lesvos (an NGO and a registered charity in the UK) are looking for a fundraiser to be based with our team on Lesvos island in Greece, one of the primary ports of entry to Europe for refugees and migrants. For over two years, the Centre has existed to provide, in solidarity: Free legal assistance, advice and representation to those seeking international protection on the island of Lesvos in Greece via the work and advocacy of an international and Greek team of volunteers, interpreters and legal staff. Those refugees and migrants who enter its shores are detained on the island awaiting their fate often for long periods of time in inhumane open-air camps. LCL seeks to bring clarity, improvement and justice to this process on this paradox of an island that has captured the hearts of so many of our long-term volunteers and staff both through the work in solidarity with migrant and refugee communities and through the captivating beauty of the island itself.

LCL are completely independent and limit our funding from individuals and donors with a similar ethical standing as our own. To ensure the sustainability of the Legal Centre we urgently need to further attract and maintain long-term funding sources for the continuation of our vital work, but in a world where people give more readily towards more tangible, short-term necessities such as food and blankets, one of your biggest challenges will be to explain the long-term and strategic nature of what we do and the impact of this on processes and systems. Ideally you will have some demonstrable experience with researching potential sources of funds, fundraising, donor relationship management, communications, and an understanding of the different types of donors as well as the knowledge of how to make funding applications. You would be a key representative of the Legal Centre and would ideally be mobile in order to travel (minimal) for any meetings or conferences with the position being based in Lesvos. This is a new position and you have the chance to make the role your own and really make an impact so would suit someone who is really hands-on and can get stuck-in as part of a collaborative, friendly and incredibly dedicated team.

Fluency in English necessary. Greek and Spanish language skills are an asset. Salary is reflective of Greek local salary within this domain.
